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## COLOURS OF CANADA SAMPLER



The fourth collaborative project from the Needlework Designers of Canada. Twenty different designers contributed to this sampler representing symbols of Canada. The sampler was created in a "round robin" manner, where it was sent via mail from one designer to the next, with no one really knowing what had been designed before their turn, or what would come after.

The results are spectacular as each stitcher added her own unique flair to the overall design, quite often depicting the part of Canada where she resides. The sampler is as diverse as it is colorful. Several techniques are used including counted cross-stitch, blackwork and hardanger.

Stitchers are encouraged to stitch the entire design, or select the motifs which appeal most to them and create their own sampler. Individual motifs would also work well on note cards, small framed pictures, pillows, and so on. The versatility is endless.
